- **Diploma of Ministry** Guided reading and self-study offered to graduates of any MDS Certificate course.




The Encounter Ministry Development School was established in 2010 and since then, over 120 men and women have completed the course and many graduates have taken up roles as pastors, church planters, youth and assistant ministry roles throughout the nation.

Beginning in 2016, The Encounter Ministry Development School added a new range of one year study options so that every believer, whether called to pastoral ministry or not, could learn and develop in serving Christ in their communities.

We believe this is a time of great opportunity for the expansion of the Kingdom of God in New Zealand. Our response to this opportunity is to co-labour with pastors from churches across the country to prepare men and women to lead and serve with faithfulness and effectiveness.

We see a new generation with strong biblical fundamentals, carrying a fresh prophetic message and anointing, and rightly connected to their local churches, their peers and mentors. They will be brilliant members of local leadership teams; they will be pastors; they will be church planters; and they will be men and women confident in Christ wherever they live and work in the world.

Three Courses + an enhancement opportunity

Students may choose a course designed to qualify them for The Encounter ...

- 1. **Certificate of Empowered Life and Ministry** a one year course that emphasises the practice of Spirit-anointed ministry
- 2. **Certificate in Biblical Studies** a one year course to understanding new covenant theology and kingdom truth
- 3. **Certificate of Ministry** a one year course for ministry development, combining ministry best practice, the supernatural and liberating truth
- 4. **Diploma of Ministry** Guided reading and self-study offered to graduates of any MDS Certificate course



The courses commence on the 5th March 2018, although if necessary, a course may be joined at the beginning of any school term. Each course requires the following participation:

Every week of a term the student is asked to view a course subject presentation consisting of two 50 minute (approx) online video sessions.
With each subject presentation completed, the student will email a short "session response" to the Dean of Students.
One Friday evening, near the end of each term, the student community will come together with the course presenters for a unique gathering - in Auckland (for North Island students) and in Christchurch (for South Island students).
Engaging with your own pastor/mentor – to review your progress and the outworking of your training in church life.

Two times each school term (follows Primary School Terms in New Zealand) the student will be sent the outlines for the sessions of their chosen course, plus the links with password to access the videos for a set of sessions. Included in this email will be "response" questions for the student to complete and return to the Dean of Students once they have viewed the session.

Dear Brent and David

For about 2 years I had been searching for a suitable Bible College Course for our Interns, Pastors Jerome and Nerene Falken; a course of study that would help them prepare for full time pastoral ministry that was ahead of them.

To be honest, I had became a bit despondent in my search for a suitable study journey for our Intern pastors. There were many theological courses available from various Bible Colleges in New Zealand and overseas that I considered, but what I was looking for was a course of study that was theologically strong but with a solid practical application, suitable for our intern pastors who worked full time and were totally committed and involved with local church ministry full time.

I had recently heard about the MDS training and sat down with pastors Brent Douglas and David Collins at a regional pastors meeting in Rotorua and shared with them my thoughts for our Interns. The outcome being, we connected with the Encounter Ministry Development School.

The fruit of the MDS has been remarkable in the further preparation of Jerome and Nerene for pastoral ministry and the local church here at BCC, so much so that two years later Jerome and Nerene were commissioned as the senior pastors of Bay Christian Centre.


I consider MDS to have played a very significant and timely role in the preparation of our intern pastors and the transition of ministry .
